1. Academic: The first step is to sign up and get the study materials. During the academic portion of your training, you'll watch a three hour DVD and read the Open Water Diver Manual. You may watch the video at home and study at your own pace. After you have studied, we'll schedule a 2 or 3 hour classroom session. We'll go over everything together and make

sure you understand all of the material. The classroom is in Hendersonville and usually on a week night from 6:00pm to 9:00pm. Call me and I'll send you the materials that you will need to start your underwater adventure.

2. Pool: This is the fun part! You will learn and practice your new SCUBA skills. You'll have plenty of time to get comfortable underwater and play with your SCUBA gear. I'll even bring an underwater camera so you may take pictures. We do the pool training in a large indoor heated pool. There are 2 four hour pool sessions included in the price. SCUBA certification is performance based and you may not need both pool sessions.



3. SCUBA Dive: This is the best part!

You will actually go SCUBA diving with your instructor. You'll complete four check-out dives over 2 days. During these dives you will demonstrate the skills you learned in the pool. In the summer we dive in Nashville at our own SCUBA quarry. Each day you'll spend about 3 hours in the water. I have SCUBA training dives most every weekend in the summer. In the winter we go to Florida or the Caribbean. You also have the option of a PADI Referral. You may complete your class and pool with me and then complete your 4 check-out dives with another PADI instructor while on your vacation.
